

Directions to Birmingham Research Park

Birmingham and the Black Country CLRN
Unit 1, West Wing, Institute of Research and Development,
Birmingham Research Park, Vincent Drive,
Birmingham, B15 2SQ

Facilities:

Free on site car parking for visitors

Local Train station - 5 minutes walk

Taxi from Birmingham New St Station – 15 minutes

Buses from Birmingham New St Station – 20/30 minutes

From the city centre:

- Follow the A38 to Bromsgrove (Bristol Road)
- After leaving the city centre, continue along the dual carriageway
- As the dual carriageway ends, turn right into Edgbaston Park Road, (at the Gun Barrels pub) following signs for Queen Elizabeth Medical Centre
- Take the next left into Pritchatts Road, go left at the mini roundabout onto Vincent Drive, and the Research park is on the left.

From the M5 Motorway:

- Leave M5 at Junction 4 and follow A38 Birmingham for 6.75 miles, after which you will encounter a major set of traffic lights
- Turn left following A4040 Harborne/QE Medical Centre passing the large Sainsburys store on your right
- After 0.75 miles, bear right at the roundabout and follow the signs for Medical School/ Blood Transfusion Centre (B4129)
- You will come to a roundabout, take the exit onto Vincent Drive (Blood Transfusion Service).
- The Research Park is on the right just after the Blood Transfusion Service and before the next junction with Pritchatts Road.

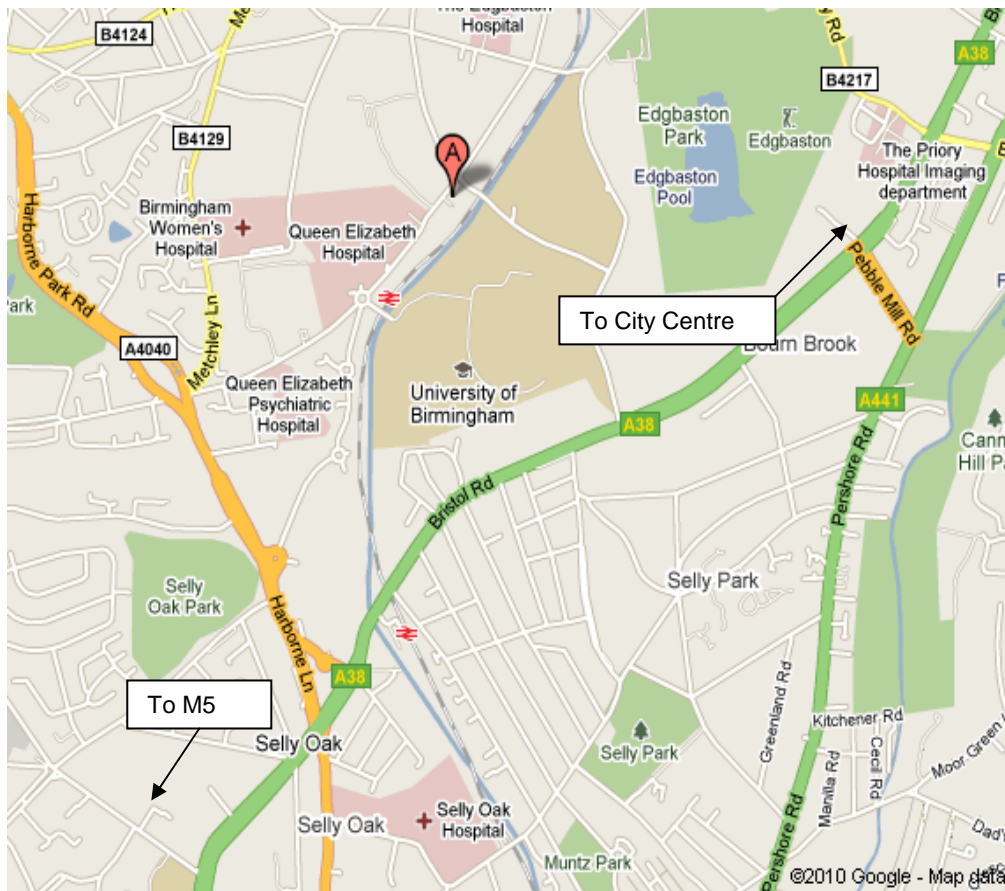
By train:

- The nearest station is University Station, which can be reached from Birmingham New Street. From the University Station, head towards the Medical School, turning right onto Vincent Drive. The Research Park is approximately 5 minutes walk, on the right hand side.

Directions from Queen Elizabeth Hospital

- Go to the bottom of the main drive (where you will see the blood bank opposite)
- Turn left and continue up Vincent Drive
- Approx 60 yards up the road you will see the Research Park on the right hand side. We have barrier controlled access and free car parking is available should you wish to use it.
- When you enter the Research Park we are in the West Wing, please inform Reception of your arrival.
